

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Shops at Liberty Place is private property. For the safety of our customers, merchants, and employees, the following items and actions are strictly prohibited:

- 1) Inappropriate behavior including: fighting, horseplay, harassment, offensive language, shouting, loud noise, littering, sleeping, or any other disturbance which disrupts or endangers any patron, guest, merchant, or employee.
- 2) Damaging any surface or portion of the shopping center, and/or sitting on any surface within the shopping center other than chairs and benches provided by Property Management. Seating areas within The Shops at Liberty Place are intended for the use of customers actively patronizing open businesses.
- 3) Non-personal sized electronics. Only electronics with headphones are permitted to be used on property.
- 4) Loitering or blocking access to store entrances, property entrances, or corridors.
- 5) Running, skating, scooters, bicycles, skateboards, hoverboards, motorized gadgets, or other similar items/activities.
- 6) Persons without shirts, shoes, or pants. Any apparel that may provoke a disturbance or incite violence. Facial coverings concealing the full face. (This does not apply to cultural, religious, or medical face coverings.)
- 7) Unauthorized use of emergency exits.
- 8) Pets, except for trained, ADA-compliant, service animals.
- 9) Open receptacles with alcoholic beverages, except in areas designated for alcohol consumption. Any illegal drugs or substances.
- 10) Soliciting for money, donations, food, personal information, picketing, distributing advertising handbills/materials, petitioning, other contributions, or engaging in other commercial activity.
- 11) All persons under 18 years old after 1 p.m., unless accompanied by a parent, a legal guardian aged 24 or older, or chaperones of a school-sponsored or other official tour group. All persons may be required to present proof of age.
- 12) The carrying of any weapon other than by an authorized law enforcement officer.
- 13) Smoking, vaping, or using e-cigarettes inside the building, or within twenty-five feet of any entrance outside the building.
- 14) Photography, filming, performances, or other entertainment not approved by the Management Office.
- 15) Helium-filled balloons.
- 16) Sexual or indecent activity anywhere on property.
- 17) Any action that violates local, state, or federal law.

Any violation of these rules may result in expulsion from the property, or other legal actions as Property Management deems appropriate.
