Code of Conduct

Anaheim GardenWalk and the Parking Deck are private property. In order to provide our guests with a safe, secure and pleasant experience, please respect the following rules. People violating this Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the property. Those who continue to violate the Code of Conduct will be restricted from returning to the property and are subject to arrest.

THE FOLLOWING IS NOT PERMITTED:

- 1. Physically or verbally threatening any person, fighting, annoying others through noisy, boisterous, or offensive behavior, following another person through GardenWalk or Parking Deck, using profane language or conduct, or obstructing or unduly interfering with normal business operations or causing a danger to guests.
- 2. Possession of any item that could be used as a weapon, including but not limited to firearms, explosives, fireworks, clubs or sticks over 1/4 inches in diameter (except umbrellas or canes), toy blasters, squirt guns, chemical dispensing devices, knives with blades over 2 inches in length, or any other objects that may be used in any way to inflict bodily injury or harm on another person. All persons and personnel are subject to inspection.
- 3. Gathering for the purpose of or resulting in disturbing the public peace or committing any unlawful act or engaging in any offensive behavior. Unauthorized events, demonstrations, speeches, distribution of printed or recorded materials are not allowed.
- 4. Engaging in expressive activity not sponsored by GardenWalk and/or an enterprise engaged in business at GardenWalk, without complying with GardenWalk's rules for such activity. This includes, without limitation, the solicitation of money or other contributions or donations, or distribution of commercial advertising or promotional material of any kind, or offering samples of items which are sold, available for sale or available in exchange for a donation or contribution. Yelling, screaming, singing, playing musical instruments, radios, tape players, or other sound amplification devices or otherwise communicating in a manner which creates noise of sufficient volume to impinge on the hearing or peace of the general public. No radio scanners, walkie talkies, or similar communication devices.
- 5. Skateboarding, roller skating, rollerblading, bicycling, riding of scooters, operation of drones, remote control toys or engaging in activities which unreasonably obstruct or interfere with the free flow of pedestrian traffic or with guests' view of windows and other tenant displays.
- 6. Wearing obscene or otherwise inappropriate apparel. Wearing masks that disguise, obscure or conceal the face other than those necessitated by a medical condition or worn for religious reasons. Wearing apparel which is likely to provide a disturbance of normal business operations or embroil other groups or the general public in open conflict.
- 7. Defacing, damaging or destroying any real or personal property constituting part of, or located in or on, GardenWalk, including distribution of material, writing, spraying, scraping or otherwise affixing graffiti on such property.
- 8. Creating litter or throwing, discarding or depositing any paper, glass or other matter of any kind at GardenWalk, except in designated trash receptacles. Rummaging through or removing items from the trash receptacles.
- 9. Photographing, videotaping, or otherwise recording any individual, entity or tenant without prior written consent of GardenWalk Management.
- 10. Sitting on floors, handrails, stairs, escalators, trash receptacles or other areas not specifically designed for seating. Do not block access to store entrances, GardenWalk entrances, corridors or packing areas.
- 11. An open flame or BBQs of any type are not allowed in the Parking Deck or any other area of GardenWalk.
